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N. Y.-LOS ANGELES AIR MAIL CONTRACT LET TO TWO FIRMS

WASHINGTON, Oct. 1.—A contract for carrying the mails by air from New York to Los Angeles, and the Transcontinental Air Transport, Inc., of Delaware.

The post office department announced Postmaster General Brown accepted a joint bid by these two companies because it was the only qualified one under the terms of the McNary-Watros act, and in conformity with the specifications in the advertisement.

The United Aviation company of Pittsburgh submitted a lower bid, but the postoffice department said it did not conform to specifications.
