Emergency Shelf Suggestions

Canned Soups—chicken, tomato, olive, beef and green string or crab, chicken, corned or clipped beef, soup, peas, asparagus, mushrooms, macaroni, beans, fruit and a vegetable salad, spaghetti, baked beans, brown bread, sliced pineapple.

Breads—Pain de France, cookies, spaghetti, cheese.

Extras—Sound coffee, ½ pound tea.

For Lunch—A soup and salad, or creamed shrimp or crab with lettuce salad, cookies and tea.

For Dinner—(1) Soup, creamed clipped beef, spaghetti and potatoes, vegetable salad, pineapple and cookies. (2) Chicken a la King, with peas, fruit salad in chocolate sauce, coffee and cookies.

For Supper—Sunday night or any time. (1) Waffle (made by following directions and pour cake flour, back, brown, soup, coffee. (2) Baked beans, brown bread and fruit salad. (3) Spaghetti mixed with creamed tomato soup, mushrooms and cheese, coffee.
