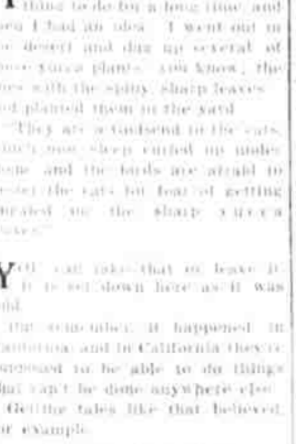
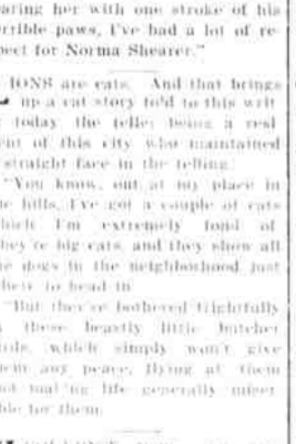
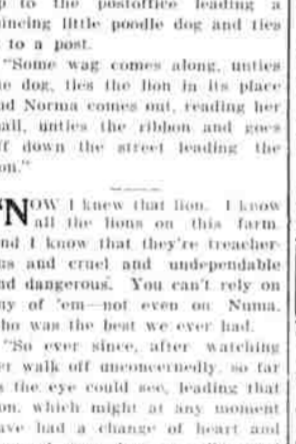
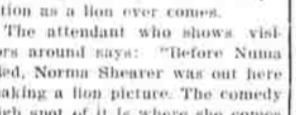
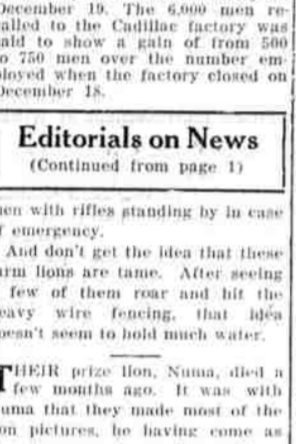
France Starts Drive To Remove Inebriates From Railroad Service

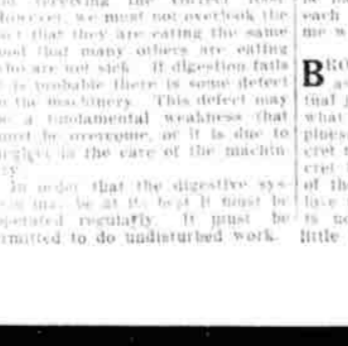
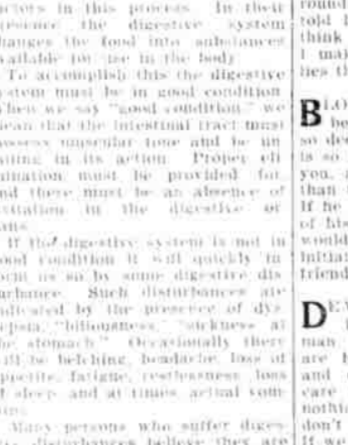
Bank Deposits on West Coast Gain
