NEW YORK, Feb. 6.—Adjudged guilty of contempt, Belle Livingston had to appear in court today to be sentenced for selling liquor at her "Town and Country Club" five days after an injunction forbade her to.
In finding her guilty yesterday, Federal Judge Francis G. Caffey said:
"It is perfectly clear to me that she contemptuously and contumaciously violated the writ. Her demeanor and testimony is unacceptable to this court."
