CHILD ADOPTION

PROPOSAL OPPOSED

60-Day Inquiry Period Not Necessary, Says Letter of Judge Hamilton.

SALEM, Feb. 10 — Members of the legislative committee of the state association of county judges and commissioners in session here today indicated that they would wage war on certain measures of the commission now pending in the legislature with some judges expressing themselves as favorable to elimination of the commission entirely as a state activity. Measures recommended by the commission provided for establishment of child welfare committees in the counties, of creation of children's boarding homes, and a measure to require a 60-day period before adoption of children to permit investigation of the persons seeking to adopt the child all met with disfavor of the committee.

Judge W. S. Hamilton of Douglas county sent a letter to the committee protesting against the 60-day investigation requirement, declaring investigation by the child welfare commission "had proved a farce," that most of such investigations were made by the juvenile officers of the county and time and expense could be saved by entrusting that office in the first instance with such investigations. He asserted the 60-day period, if required by law, would mean in most instances that the juveniles would be cared for by the counties for that period or longer pending investigation. County Judge Barnard of Lane seconded his views.

Other judges stated they were in possession of information that members of the commission had referred to them as "stagnant judges," unacquainted with the social sciences and also intimated the commission was endeavoring to foist trained social workers on the counties.
