DIPHTHERIA AGAIN SCOURGES ALASKA

Point Barrow's Hospital
Overcrowded and Anti-
Toxin Is Needed.

(Associated Press Special Wire)
POINT BARROW, Alaska, March 12.—This little village again was in the grip of a diphtheria epidemic today, her only hospital filled to overflowing and practically all available antitoxin used. The health bureau at Fairbanks was delaying the sending of more serum because of the expense.
Dr. Henry Griest of the Presbyterian hospital reported two new cases of diphtheria and quarantined two more houses. A constant guard was being kept and no one is allowed to enter or leave the village.
Early immunizations were proving of little effect because the serum then on hand was old and doses necessarily small. The new supply brought here by airplane Sunday from Fairbanks by Pilot Joe Crosson practically was used up immediately and if more is sent at once, further appeals for the serum and other help will be sent out.
Dr. Griest said if the situation at Wainwright becomes more serious the need for antitoxin will be far in excess of 500,000 units. Wainwright is southwest of here on the coast.
Airplanes at Fairbanks belonging to a moving picture company enroute here to take pictures were to bring an additional supply of antitoxin this week. It was not known now if they would be sent on the mission, with the health bureau hesitating because of the expense.
There is no physician or antitoxin at Wainwright and Dr. Griest is caring for patients at Point Hope, Demarcation and here.
