SPECIALTY CROPS BRING FAMILIES

Profitable specialty crops are attracting many families to all parts of Oregon from the grain and cotton sections of eastern states, according to the March report of the state chamber of commerce which shows 48 new families who arrived during the month and invested \$19,250 in 4,816 acres of land and in other forms of property. Inquiries about investment opportunities and from people seeking a more congenial climate continue to come and 2,385 letters were received during March. There were 83 families who wrote of their intentions of coming to Oregon within the next few weeks.

One San Diego produce company will plant 240 acres to peas in Coos county to be sold in the fresh state in eastern markets; one Salem cannery has contracted for over 200 acres of asparagus; an out-state concern has contracted for several hundred acres of peas for seed purposes in Umatilla county. Benton county farmers last year received over \$100,000 for specialty seed crops are planted. Alfalfa, clover and vetch seeds and bent grass seed for lawns will require large acreages in Clatsop, Coos, Josephine, Deschutes and Malheur counties and bring very satisfactory returns to our farmers.

Woman Aerialist in Barnes' Circus Falls; Husband Continues Act

(Associated Press Special Wire) LOS ANGELES, April 7.—True to circus tradition, Alex Acevo carried on with his aerial act last night while his wife, Arrolia, lay near death from a plunge to earth a few hours before. Acevo, aided by others, pulled his wife to the top of the Al G. Barnes tent. She and three others suspended only by rubber mouthpieces clamped between their teeth, began to spin rapidly in the "butterfly" act. Suddenly, as hundreds gasped in horror, Mrs. Acevo dropped. Her husband ran forward in an attempt to break her fall with his body but she crashed limp at his feet. Time for the night performance came and Acevo walked across a slack wire high above the ground in perfect balance, distance hiding the grimness of his face from the crowd. Mrs. Acevo, 30, was still unconscious at the Hollywood police emergency hospital early today. Attendants said her skull and pelvis apparently had been fractured. It had not been determined whether she lost her grip or a swivel broke.

Planet Dives for Earth LONDON.—The planet Eros is plunging toward the earth at terrific speed but astronomers are remaining calm. It still has 16,000,000 miles to travel before the crash is expected. Eros, discovered by a German in 1898, is distinguished from other planets by the fact that its path at one point lies nearest to that of the earth. Astronomers throughout the world are taking photographs of it twice nightly as part of an attempt to measure the sun's distance from the earth.
