ALFALFA GROWING IS DEMONSTRATED

Product of Umpqua Valley Farms Is Exhibited at Two Meetings.

Growing alfalfa successfully on well drained bench and hill land was demonstrated Friday on the L. E. Thompson farm at Umpqua. The stand was found to be perfect, the plants a dark, vigorous green color, 10 to 12 inches in height at the present time. The stand and growth was a surprise to the farmers gathered for the meeting, Friday morning, arranged by County Agent J. C. Leedy, in cooperation with Mr. Thompson. Three acres of alfalfa were planted by Mr. Thompson May first of last year. The soil was plowed at the rate of one ton to the acre. Superphosphate 100 pounds to each acre was broadcast over the ground and disced in. The discing worked the soil down and killed the weeds. Continued cultivation with a spike-tooth harrow kept all weeds from starting and by May 1 the ground was packed very firm. In fact, might be called hard with the exception of an inch or inch and a half mulch on top. The seed was inoculated and planted at once. Mr. Thompson said the seed was up in five days and continued to grow all summer in fine shape. A few days after the seed was up land-plaster was applied at the rate of 125 pounds to the acre. "A better practice, however," stated E. R. Jackman, crops specialist of the state college, speaker at the demonstration, "is to apply about 100 pounds of land-plaster ten days or two weeks before seeding. This gives a chance for the land-plaster to work into the soil and be ready to assist the young plants on starting growth."

Grimm Variety Advised Grimm alfalfa was recommended by Mr. Jackman in that it has a greater root system than many of the common types and does better under western Oregon conditions. "Purchasing of certified seed is the surest way of getting the best seed and knowing it is the variety desired. Common alfalfa may be any variety of alfalfa or a mixture of varieties," said Mr. Jackman. "as the original source of the seed is not known."

Stockmen and turkey raisers should have a small planting of alfalfa for green feed. It has been found to be the cheapest, contains the greatest food value and is green the entire summer when other crops are dried up, and as a hay crop is ideal for the sheep raiser and dairyman."

Another successful meeting was held during the afternoon on the farm of R. R. Clarke at Oakland. The planting visited was on river bottom ground and gave a wonderful yield of hay and pasture the past year.

PRODUCERS OF EGGS ASKS HIGHER TARIFF

Imports From China Said Menace to Pacific Coast Industry.

SAN FRANCISCO, April 13.—President Hoover and the federal tariff commission have been asked by John E. Pickett, agricultural economist, to increase the duty on eggs imported from China to prevent another \$200,000,000 loss to the American egg industry. This sum represented the loss in income to American poultry men last year due to a 27 cent cent slump in prices. Pickett, who is editor of the Pacific Rural Press, told the commission. "At a time when the egg price cycle should have tilted upward meaning that it would, a flood of cheap, processed Chinese eggs came into the country," Pickett said in an open letter. "These Chinese eggs were just about equivalent to the entire surplus of storage eggs in the country, and exerted a powerful price depression influence. "This has probably cost the hen owners of the nation more in the last 18 months than it cost to build the Panama canal."

Another menace seen in the Chinese imports was the statement of Dr. Walter F. Holst of the University of California to the state legislature, that the imports were equivalent to 60,000,000 dozen fresh American eggs and that they displaced 250,000 tons of American feed. With silver at its present low level, Pickett estimated the sale price of eggs in China at three cents a dozen. He urged a 50 per cent increase in the tariff, from 18 cents to 27 cents a pound. The tariff commission will conduct a hearing in Washington April 16.
