WASHINGTON, March 13.—(AP)—The federal air commerce bureau announced today approval of 25 additional airport projects and 17 air marking programs proposed for development with works progress administration funds. The bureau's approval is required before the WPA will allot funds for the projects and means they are considered satisfactory from a technical standpoint but does not assure allotments of funds. The projects included: Oregon—Bandon, \$19,295; Madras, \$6,185; air marking (state-wide) \$12,823.
