NAZIS STILL COOL TOWARD ECKENER

Zeppelin Head Shoved Into Background at Reception to Returned Craft.

FRANKFURT ON THE MAIN, Germany, May 14.—Surpassing all records for both eastward and westward crossings of the Atlantic the giant German Zeppelin Hindenburg touched ground at 5:45 a. m. to end its first flight from America.

The official flying time for the voyage from Lakehurst, N. J., was given as 49 hours, three minutes, during which the great air cruiser covered 6,570 kilometers (4,168.75 miles).

With its landing mechanism functioning perfectly, the Hindenburg rested in its vast new hangar, signaling completion of its maiden roundtrip between Germany and the United States with passengers, mails and freight.

Municipal officials arranged a city hall reception in honor of Dr. Hugo Eckener, president of the Zeppelin company, and Capt. Ernest Lehmann, commander of the Hindenburg.

Dr. Eckener and Captain Lehmann were given silver cups from State Governor Chas. Sprenger in the official reception, but Eckener was moved again into the background.

The Nazi governor, in the presence of other state functionaries, turned to Lehmann and welcomed him as commander of the Hindenburg. The captain, speaking in the name of the Hindenburg's crew, replied to the greetings during the reception.

Despite previous reports from Zeppelin headquarters that all would be well when the veteran "admiral of the air" returned, Eckener's name was omitted again from the report of the official German news agency and newspapers which printed an interview with Lehmann.

The absence of Dr. Eckener's name from the press, was interpreted by informed sources as a clear indication the German air pioneer was still out of favor after his recent differences with the propaganda ministry.

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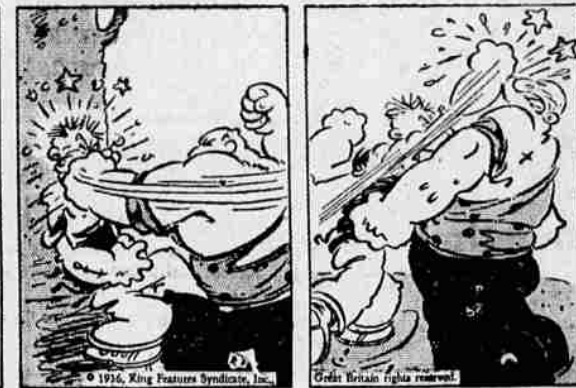
