

LOAFERS MUST TOIL, MARTIN DECLARES

SALEM, June 22.—(AP)—The plea of eastern Oregon now is "for God's sake, relieve us of relief."

The eastern section is facing a labor shortage, the executive declared, and the major problem there is to find men who will work.

"County judges have appealed to me for aid and their cry is for relief from relief."

The executive stated that one employer went so far as to ask him to pardon a man from jail so he could get him to work.

"I will not stand in the way of anyone who wants to work," Martin told his listeners. "Prosperity has returned to Oregon and this is no time for whiners."

No other reference was made by the executive to the relief controversy which has plagued the past ten days after his order to the relief committee to "pay as you go."

MULTNOMAH WILL CUT RELIEF COSTS

PORTLAND, June 22.—(AP)—Gradual reduction in overhead costs will reduce the expenses of the Multnomah county relief commission between \$40,000 and \$50,000 a month, Jefferson Myers, county-relief chairman, said today.

"The expenditure must be reduced for there is no money to pay it and still provide relief," Myers said. He said 2,500 applications for pensions already have been acted on and that 500 more are still to be investigated.

Myers said costs already have been reduced \$1,300 a month. The contemplated reduction will mean that about one-third of the relief staff will be removed from the payroll.

Present expenses of the county office range between \$20,000 and \$25,000 a month, Myers said.

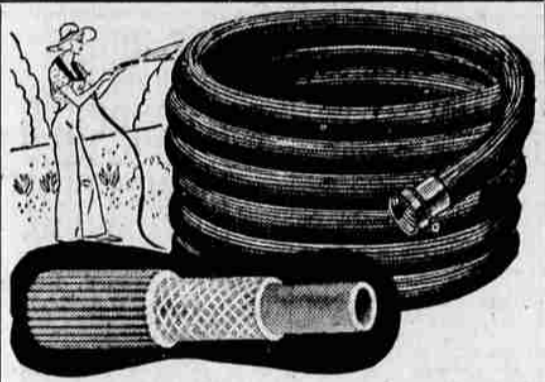
