LOS ANGELES, July 1.—(AP)—A plea of guilty to a charge of attempting to extort \$1,000 from Mrs. Will Rogers, widow of the late actor and humorist, was entered in federal court today by Joseph E. Snyder, 72, former cowpuncher. He will appear for sentence Monday.

The elderly man was charged by federal agents with having sent threatening letters to Mrs. Rogers, and attempted to sell her a manuscript for \$1,000.
