RETAIL PRICES OF FOOD GO HIGHER

WASHINGTON, July 1.—(AP)—The labor department reported today that retail food prices rose 2.7 per cent during the two weeks ending June 16, the advance bringing food costs to the highest level since April, 1931.

Principal factors contributing to the advance were continued increases in prices for fresh fruits and vegetables and higher prices for butter and eggs, the department said.

Food costs during the two weeks were 2.8 per cent above the same period last year.
