STUDEBAKER SALES RECORD NEW HIGH

SOUTH BEND, Ind., July 22.—(Special)—Export sales of Studebaker passenger cars and trucks reached a new high during the first half of 1936, according to Paul G. Hoffman, president of the Studebaker corporation. Mr. Hoffman states that 6,633 units were sold abroad during this period, compared with 5,063 during the first six months of 1935—a gain of 31 per cent.

Deliveries of passenger cars and trucks by Studebaker in the United States alone totaled 1,754 during the first 10 days of July, compared with 1,345 during the corresponding period last year—an increase of 30 per cent. American retail deliveries for the year to date are 98 per cent ahead of 1935—39,918 compared with 23,557.
