DEATH DRIVER TO FACE GRAND JURY

MEDFORD, Ore., July 30.—(AP)—The Jackson county grand jury will investigate the death of Avis Brood, 13-year-old Central Point girl, on recommendation of the coroner's jury which issued a verdict of negligence involving Z. Riggs, Hillsboro, and the unknown driver of another car. The girl was fatally injured when her bicycle collided with Riggs' car at an intersection here.

Testimony was given to show the girl was in front of the Hillsboro man's machine to avoid another car. Riggs, who stopped to render aid and report the mishap, was released on his own recognition.

SALEM, July 30.—(AP)—The trial of Police Chief Frank Minto on charges of negligence of duty continued today with indications it would go to the jury by tonight.

Minto appeared as a witness for his own defense late yesterday and testified that he could and would have closed up gambling in Salem if he had had "available means."

Charges against Minto resulted from a recent gambling investigation in Marion county. A previous trial of the chief of police on charges of failure to enforce the gambling ordinances resulted in a hung jury.

PROSECUTRIX QUILTS MEDFORD; MAN FREED

MEDFORD, Ore., July 29.—(AP)—Prosecution of Thomas Adams, jeweler, formerly of San Jose, Calif., collapsed yesterday in justice court, when it was revealed that Janet Ann Mills, a minor girl and prosecutrix, had departed the day before for a home of her parents in Walthill, Neb.

The complaint was signed by the girl's sister, Mrs. Bertha McVeigh of this city.

Adams was scheduled to be released from the county jail today.

District Attorney George A. Coddling said the case would be given an airing at the next session of the Jackson county grand jury.
