

NAZIS GET WARNING AT SOVIET PARLEY

Defeat Awaits Attempt to
Conquer Ukraina, Says
Prime Minister.

MOSCOW, Nov. 26.—(AP)—The most inglorious defeat in history awaits Germany if she attacks the Ukraine, M. Lubchenko, prime minister of the Ukrainian republic, told the all-union congress of soviets today.

"Hitler will not find us as easy to conquer as East Prussia and the Rhineland," he declared.

Using the strongest language of any of the authoritative soviet reports to the German chancellor's anti-bolshevik speech at Nurnberg, Lubchenko cried:

"The Nazis dream of destroying the soviet union. Our answer to them is contained in the Cosacks' famous letter to the Turkish sultan." This letter, one of the most vulgar in history, is depicted in Repin's noted painting, "The Answer of the Cosacks to Sultan Mahmoud IV."

He continued:
"We Ukrainians have a popular saying now for Hitler. It is: 'Just as a pig never sees the sky, so Hitler will see our vegetable gardens.'"

Nazi Envoy Ousted.
He chided Poland, declaring "the Poles seem to forget that Rosenberg (Dr. Alfred Rosenberg, Nazi foreign affairs official) wrote that destruction of Poland is the first demand of German policy. When they talk of the soviet union they do not remember they are in danger of being strangled by Germany."

Referring directly to the German-Japanese anti-communist agreement, Lubchenko declared: "A crusade is being prepared against the soviet union by a holy alliance," and recalled Ukrainian "suffering" under the Germans in 1918.

He was roundly applauded.

Stalin Speaks.
Joseph Stalin made one of his rare public addresses last night after the delegates had given him a rousing ovation.

He accused German newspapers of "discrediting" facts when they found events did not jibe with Nazi theories.

Stalin stressed his view of the new constitution as merely the solidification of what the communist regime already has accomplished.

Five characteristics, he said, distinguished it from any foreign charter. He mentioned:
1. Socialism definitely has conquered in Russia and there can be no more exploitation of man by man.

2. A unified national policy among 160 national groups in the soviet union has proved a definite success.

3. The soviet charter is based on the right of everyone to work on the basis of individual qualifications.

4. All class distinctions are eliminated and race equality is guaranteed.

5. The soviet charter guarantees democracy to all.

AUTO UPSET KILLS VISITOR IN LANE

EUGENE, Nov. 26.—(AP)—Darwin Orton, of Union, Ore., was fatally injured at 10 o'clock Wednesday night when a car in which he was riding overturned on the Dorena road three miles east of Cottage Grove.

The young man was in a car driven by Oral H. Anderson of Cottage Grove, who was uninjured. Traveling east, the car ran into loose gravel by the side of the road and swerved into the ditch, turning over on its side.

A state police officer on his beat in that district came along a minute later and extricated the injured youth, taking him to a physician in Cottage Grove.

Orton had been visiting at the home of friends at Cottage Grove. His parents were on the way to that city from Union Thursday.

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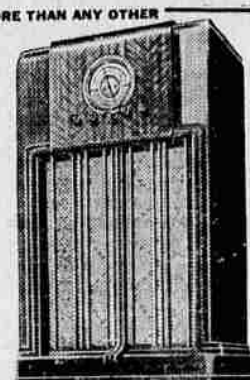

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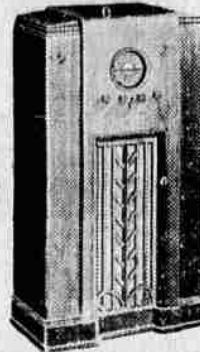
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
