

BIGGEST SALARY PAYMENTS SHOWN

WASHINGTON, Jan. 6.—(AP)—A peek into the pay envelopes of some of the nation's big men and women, afforded by a treasury department report to congress, showed today that top salaries went to movie stars and captains of industry.

The voluminous document, made public by the house ways and means committee, answered at least some of the questions concerning what "the other fellow" made in 1935. Salaries of more than \$15,000 were listed.

William Randolph Hearst, the publisher, maintained his position as the country's leading wage earner with pay checks of \$500,000.

Mae West, the throaty-voiced siren of the screen, ran him a close second with earnings of \$480,823. She topped all film stars, including Janet Gaynor, last year's highest paid actress, whose 1935 income totaled \$109,750.

Charlie Chaplin's salary was listed at \$200,000. The late Will Rogers earned \$258,000. Bing Crosby received \$318,907; Marlene Dietrich, \$368,000; and Joe E. Brown, \$173,438.

The lugubrious film humor of Stan Laurel netted him \$156,206.

Nickles and dimes poured into the cash registers of the F. W. Woolworth company gave its president, B. D. Miller, an annual compensation of \$309,880.

General Motors corporation paid President Alfred P. Sloan, Jr., \$375,505 and William S. Knudsen, director and executive vice-president, \$325,860. Ten other officials drew more than \$200,000.

COLONY FOUNDING TO BE CELEBRATED

WILMINGTON, Del., Jan. 7.—(AP)—Plans are under way to celebrate in 1938 the centenary of the birth of New Sweden with federal, Swedish and several state governments participating.

Eighteen years after Pilgrims first set foot on Plymouth rock, another group of settlers—the Swedes—landed on the fertile banks of a calm river 300 miles to the south and took possession of the country in the name of the Swedish crown.

Thus was founded the colony of New Sweden that existed in its own right from 1638 until 1655 and left a lasting impression on the culture and government of Delaware, Maryland, Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

Foremost in the aims of those in charge of the celebration is acquisition for park purposes of the landing place of the pioneers.

The Beavers drew ahead early in last night's game but Harry Mosher, Hearcat guard, whanged in a long one just before the half ended with the Beavers on the long end of a 12 to 11 score.

Willamette kept the lead there after, at one time sending it to six points.

ASHLAND, Ore., Jan. 7.—(AP)—Southern Oregon Normal's 1936-37 basketball record against Linfield college remained unblemished today as a result of last night's 25 to 24 victory. It was the normal team's fourth straight win over the Wildcats.

Linfield held a 12 to 8 lead at half time and until the final few minutes was out in front 22 to 14. Bill Hoxie, normal forward, sank the winning basket from mid-court less than two minutes before the final gun.

The visitors led 31 to 20 with but six minutes to play, but failed to match the Mountaineers' final drive to victory.

PORTLAND, Jan. 7.—(AP)—Multnomah club crushed the Pacific university basketball team 43 to 24 here last night. The clubbers, led by Liebowitz, were out in front 20 to 8 at half time and never were headed.

Before the largest throng in the history of tennis anywhere, 17,630 sitting and standing customers, who paid \$58,119.50 to see the show, Perry made his professional debut at Madison square garden last night by upsetting Vines, 7-5, 3-6, 6-3, 6-1.

U. S. NATIONAL HAS BIG DEPOSIT GAIN

The United States National bank, which has a direct branch in this city, reports a gain in deposits of over eleven million dollars in the past twelve months, according to official statement issued to the comptroller of currency as of December 31, 1936. During the same period resources increased approximately twelve and one-half million dollars, or at the rate of more than one million dollars a month. Deposits, as of above date, total \$113,812,384.26, and resources \$123,343,148.92.

Capital, surplus, undivided profits and reserves have increased \$1,222,247.12, including \$750,000 which was added to the capital funds by the issuance of new stock June 30, 1936.

An interesting comparison was shown between the United States National's statement of December 31, 1936, and December 31, 1935, at which time the bank's deposits totaled \$62,323,578.63. In other words, there has been a gain of \$51,588,805.63.

The Roseburg National bank became a branch of the United States National in December, 1936, and according to E. S. McClain, manager, is showing a healthy growth in deposits. "At the same time," said Mr. McClain, "increased commercial activity is putting more money into circulation locally and thus is benefitting the community at large."

MARTIN WILL ASK FOR MINING BUREAU

SALEM, Jan. 6.—(AP)—Headed by Senator James T. Chinnock, a delegation of Josephine county residents urged upon Governor Martin today the need of a state mining bureau.

Chinnock estimated mining investments in the county during the past two years totaled more than a million dollars, pointing out the rapid stride of the industry recently.

"Had it not been for the mining industry Josephine county's roller outlay would have been doubled," Chinnock said.

The governor stated he would incorporate a request for a mining bureau in his biennial message to the 1937 legislature.
