"Miracle Mother" of Sextuplets



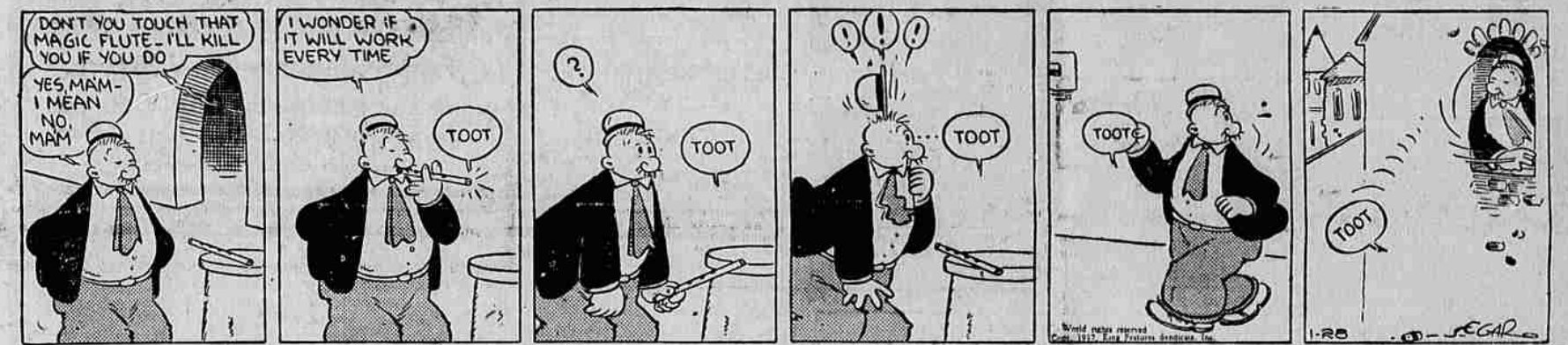
