SALEM, Feb. 19.—(AP)—In a lotter to Governor Martin by Frank T. Hines, administrator of the veterans administration in Washington it was pointed out to day that all persons in the old state soldiers home at Roseburg at time of its transfer to the veterans administration would remain at the Roseburg facility.

This letter came on the heels of ugitation in the lower house to create a commission to inspect the facility in an attempt to straighten out alleged confusion and misunderstanding as to its purpose and plans among Oregon veterans.

It was decided some time ago to convert the home into a neurophysehatric hospital.

The letter said in part:

"In the studies of the federal board of hospitalization in an effort to adequately care for the requirements of the veterans administration in the several areas throughout the country, the utilization of existing facilities to the best advantage as a subject is always given careful consideration.
