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Streamlined Caboose

AS THE streamline and spruce-up movement spreads across the United States, a number of old familiar landmarks are disappearing. Now it begins to look as if one of the most familiar of all—the old red cabooses, with its little cupola on top—is about to be submerged.

At any rate, the Milwaukee road is coming out with a set of new cabooses which apparently are going to be almost as fancy and decorative as observation cars. The cupola will be gone; instead, there will be expansive bay windows at the sides. Instead of being the traditional brick-red in color, the caboose will be painted a silvery aluminum with black trim.

Inside, the car will be roomier, airier and far more comfortable, with such conveniences for the train crew as built-in refrigerator, and leather upholstered side seats which can quickly be converted into beds.

All of this no doubt is necessary, and should make for happier train crews and handsome freight trains. But that old red caboose is a cherished and familiar part of the American scene. The country just won't look natural if they take it away from us, no matter how good-looking its replacement may be.

Safety Hint

A REPORT of the National Safety Council suggests the strange fact that traffic lights, rather than helping to eliminate traffic accidents and deaths, may really increase them.

In January, 1936, the city of Bayonne, N. J., eliminated its traffic lights. Behind this move, according to its police chief, was the belief that the system had encouraged reckless driving; that motorists were apt to get into accidents by speeding up to beat the lights.

Now comes the report of the National Safety Council that Bayonne is the largest city in the nation without a traffic death in the first quarter of this year.

Traffic lights certainly are nuisances, at least to drivers. That they may also be a detriment to public safety is something that other cities may want to investigate.

dependents in the small towns and cities of the country. It seeks ESPECIALLY HARD the little corporations that are in debt.

IN AN effort to understand the workings of this vicious tax, let us imagine two corporations. One is old, long-established and out of debt. The other is new, struggling and heavily in debt.

The old, long-established, debt-free corporation is touched very lightly by the undistributed profits tax, because it can use its profits to pay dividends to its stockholders. The new, struggling, heavily involved corporation is HIT HARD, because it has to pay a heavy PENALTY TAX for the privilege of using its profits to pay its debts.

Nothing could be more unfair than that.

IF YOU are an average citizen, you think of a corporation as something big and wicked and powerful. That isn't true. A corporation is merely a device to enable little fellows to pool their resources, and more than 90 per cent of all corporations are LITTLE.

ANY scheme that taxes the fellow who is IN DEBT far

heavier than the fellow who is OUT OF DEBT is an unfair and unwise scheme.

The New Deal tax on undistributed profits (so called) does just that.

As Henry Ford says, its result over a period of time will be to tax the little fellow out of existence—especially the little fellow who is struggling to get a start.

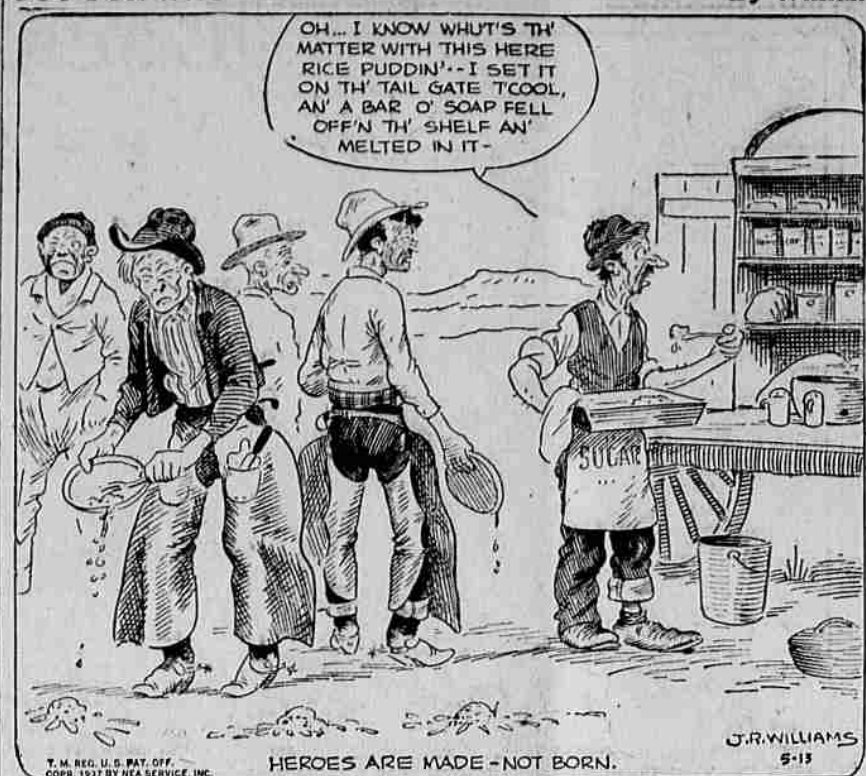
