## SUICIDE SERVED IN WORLD WAR

Waldo H. Young, 44, found dead yesterday at Camp Veto, Calif., death being self-inflicted, was born at Cleveland, Ohio, April 23, 1893. He came to Roseburg from Los Angeles nine months ago, and engaged here in operation of a taxi service prior to taking over the cafe.

He was a veteran of the World War and a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Surviving are his wife and a six-month-old son, Robert, of Roseburg, and Jean and Clark Young of Los Angeles, children of a former marriage. He also leaves his mother, Mrs. Lillie Young, Cleveland, Ohio, and two sisters, Mrs. A. H. Davis, San Pedro, California, and Mrs. Warren Leet, Cleveland.

The body was removed to the Douglas Funeral home. Arrangements for services will be made after the arrival of relatives expected today from California.
