BANKRUPTCY HITS NOTED G. O. P. CLUB CHICAGO, Jan. 12.—(AP)—The life blood of the Hamilton club, Chicago's elite which reputedly has existed for 47 years, trickled through an auctioneer's fingers today when public sale of the furnishings began.

For three days the financial tragedy of the defunct 16-story clubhouse in which two presidents, Harding and Coolidge, slept, will be publicly paraded while the inmate possessions of the institution are knocked down to the highest bidder.

A commercial auctioneering firm bought the furnishings for \$22,500 after the club forfeited its lease by bankruptcy court because of \$150,000 rent delinquency.

Everything was subject to "what an excellent thing, that is, except the symbolic stuffed elephant which the court ruled should be placed with some republican organization, a museum or destroyed.

Numerous delegations from sportsmen's clubs of Oregon will attend the reserve hearing, and a large number are expected to remain for the entertainment.

Any man carrying a 1938 membership card from any sportsmen club in Oregon or adjoining states will be eligible to attend the party. However, a membership card will be required for admission.

The program will include talks by the members of the game commission and by prominent sportsmen, motion pictures, music and other features.

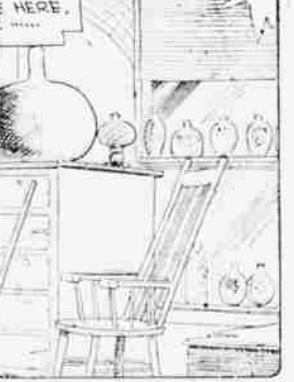
