CORVALLIS, Feb. 10.—(AP)—An investigation of the fatal shooting of Charles Kirby, 23, Oregon State college student, on January 27 was under way today by the city council. Kirby was shot by Police Officer Aaron Dearing after he was alleged to have disregarded an order to halt when Dearing tried to apprehend a man peeping in a window. A coroner's jury exonerated Dearing. The action of the council followed petitions from a group of citizens.
