Attacking this statement, Clement R. Attlee, leader of the opposition, declared: "We have had promises of this kind before—none of them have been kept."

The opposition leader called the Chamberlain move a "pitiful surrender" to a "bankrupt dictator" and said it would have a "most serious effect in the United States."
