SEASONAL HIGH FOR WOOL PRICE SET

PORTLAND, April 28.—(AP)—A wool company representative reported the sale of 500 fleeces from the Rugg brothers ranch near Echo today for 19 1/2 cents a pound, the highest price in the northwest this season.

The representative, Harold G. Russell of the Portland Hide & Wool company, said price conditions were generally more favorable. He attributed the high quality of stock and wool to excellent feed conditions and the comparatively mild winter.
