

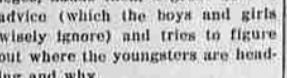

Inventories are moving slowly. Automobiles are in bad shape. Widespread wage cuts are threatened. Steel production would be as low as its lowest point in the last depression except for government business. National income, which was up to a rate of 76 billion dollars this time last year, is now running at the rate of \$5 billion a year—a loss of about \$1,250,000,000 a month.

Soon, according to present plans, the president will take off on a long trip, while his strategists bend themselves to nominating new dealers in the primaries. The brightest spots in the picture he will leave behind him, unless something pops up meanwhile, are a desire in Washington to get the pump-priming program started as quickly as possible and a general belief that if the situation isn't better by late August or September, he will have to think of something new.
