OFFICER OF MARINE CORPS SHOT IN ROW

KANSAS CITY, Kas., June 23.—(AP)—A marine corps petty officer tumbled downstairs with a fatal bullet wound early today after a housewarming party at the fashionable Lake of the Forest and a fellow officer was charged with murdering him.

Sergeant Edgar J. Rodgers, 37, was accused of killing Arthur C. Noeller, 40, chief petty officer at the Fairfax airport. Rodgers told officer Noeller attempted to kiss the hostess, Mrs. Judith Sudbrink, 26, but she resisted him. Rodgers roomed at the Sudbrink home.

Mrs. Sudbrink's husband, Harold, died.
