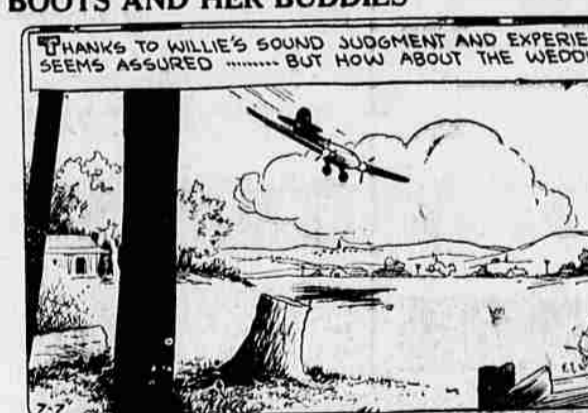

## 2 MORE PENALIZED IN LIQUOR ROUNDUP

MEDFORD, Ore., July 7.—(AP)—Donald F. Cook, taxi driver, and Howard F. Doran, bailiiff, charged with unlawful sale of intoxicating liquor, were each sentenced to 90 days in the county jail and fined \$50 and costs in justice court today. Both entered pleas of guilty.

Cook paid the fine and the jail sentence was suspended. Doran was given time to pay, and also had his jail term suspended.

The pair were arrested as the result of a not spread here last week by state liquor control board investigators and the sheriff's office, in which five other persons, including one woman, were arrested and given similar sentences.

In the cases, state liquor board agent testified, he purchased from the defendants for \$150 per pint, whiskey that sold for 80 cents at the state liquor store.
