Oddities Gleaned From Day's News

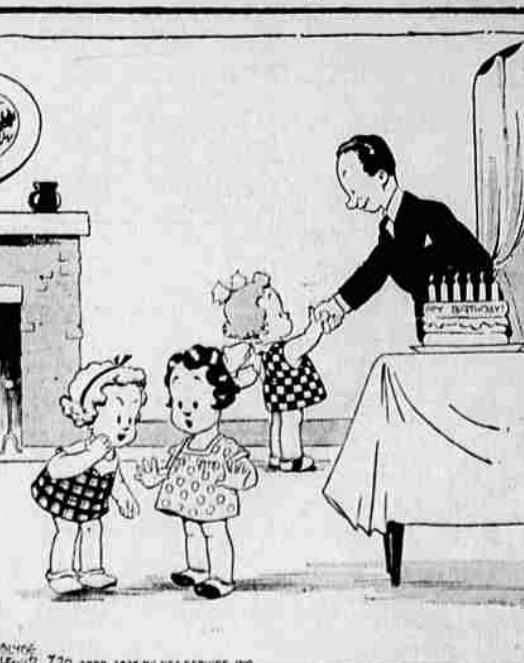

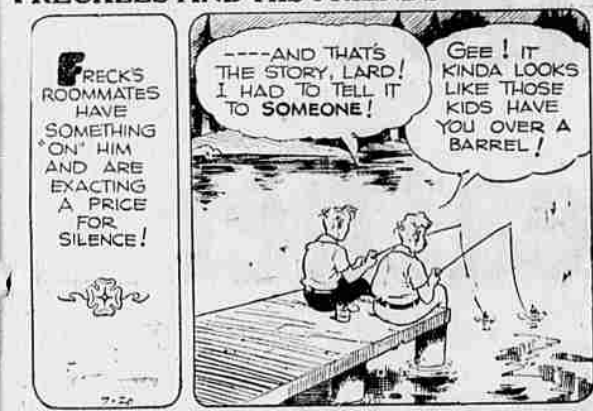

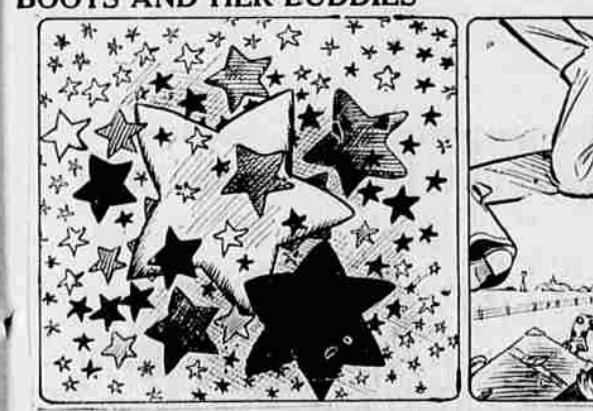
