Bungalow Camps and Mountain Lodges in Canada Now Lure Anglers and Lovers of Skyline Trails



THE fisherman who knew his Canada was talking: "Want a big musky—Canadians call him maskinonge—want a streamlined, fighting, freshwater tiger? Try French River Bungalow Camp, French River, Ontario, north of Toronto. And if luck is with you, listen! A 35-pounder struck, three times he took 75 yards of my line, twice he leaped clear of the water to break line or hook, once he rushed under the canoe. For 25 minutes he fought, then I reeled him in and the Indian guide did the rest! Small and

large mouth bass and great northern pike, too.

"Want goldeyes, pickerel, whitefish, pike, tullibee? Try Devil's Gap Bungalow Camp, Kenora, Ontario, in the vast Lake of the Woods region. And you can swim, fish, sail, paddle your own canoe, play golf and tennis.

"There are mountain lodges in the Canadian Rockies where you ride, hike, climb, fish, explore and study wildflowers and fossils, breathe the clean mountain air and eat the good camp food of the cook who says 'Come and get it' or the chalet food of the chef who sends word that 'dinner is served.' Near Field, B. C. is famous Emerald Lake Chalet on Emerald Lake, outstanding jade-green rival of even Lake Louise. Nearby are bungalow camps at

Yoho Valley where the roar of lofty Takakkaw Falls lulls one to sleep, Lake Wapta overlooking its namesake and majestic mountains, Lake O'Hara, whose beauty John Singer Sargent painted for a week; and Radium Hot Springs, noted for curative waters and scenic charm.

"Over pony trail from Banff is Mount Assiniboine Lodge, near Mount Assiniboine, Matterhorn of the Canadian Rockies, which wears a gigantic glacier round its neck as a lovely woman wears a white fox fur. Near each camp are picturesque trails, Alpine-flowered meadows, towering peaks challenging the mountain climber, and in streams or lakes fishing for brook-trout, cut-throat trout, steelheads or perhaps a big Dolly Varden! As the camp cook says: 'Come and get it! Why not?'
