Lowine reasons why the Deer Creek site is considered the best for city park purposes: It will be centrally located to every part of the city; most of the land to be used for the park already is owned by the city; a large tract adjoining that owned by the city will be donated to the city for park purposes; water and sewer systems and city lights already are installed on the property; the grounds will be easy to landscape, as it already has 89 fine trees growing upon it and is bounded on the north by Deer Creek; the property will be bounded upon three sides by paved streets; travelers on the highway will be attracted to the park immediately upon entering the city from the north.

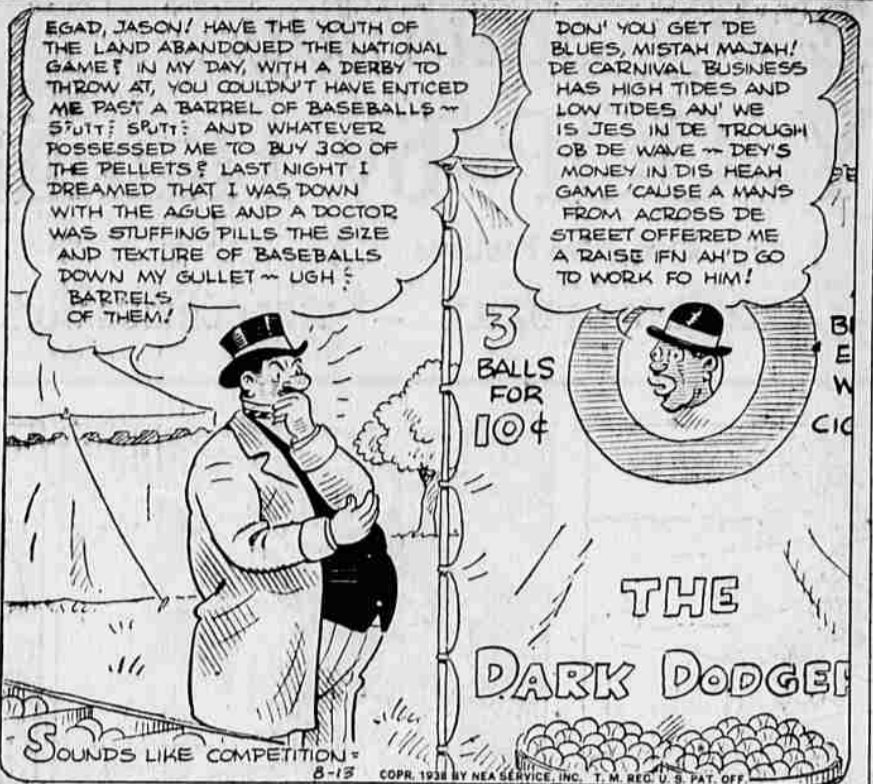
FRONTIER ITALIAN BORDER CLOSED; TENSION HIGH

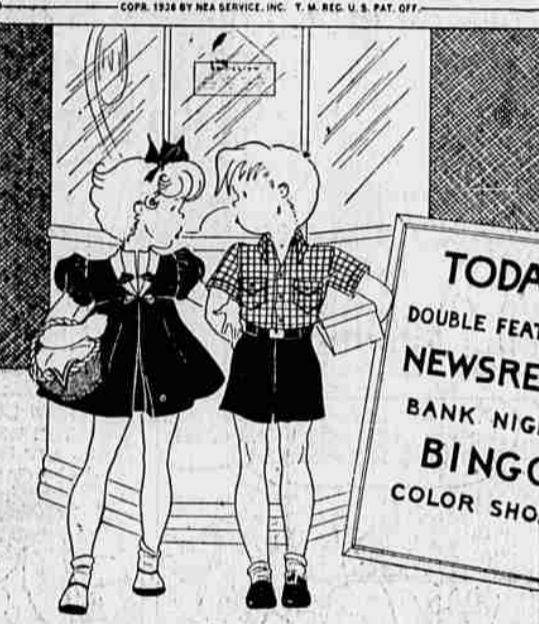
