JAPS TAKE CANTON: CHINESE RETREAT

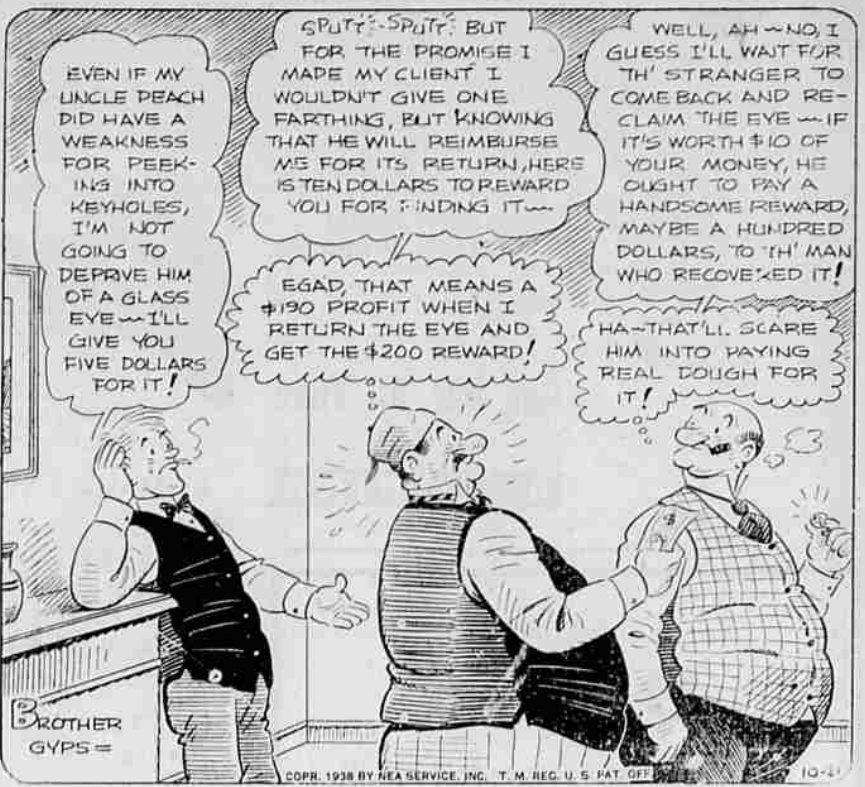

The extent to which the accused ends and aims of the works program has been impaired and defeated through selfish aims and ambitions of individuals entrusted with its administration or who sought political advantage, has amazed your grand jury," the report said.

The indictments were divided into two classes—conspiracy indictments against 62 persons with a maximum penalty of two years imprisonment and \$10,000 fine, and direct violation indictments for political discrimination, with a maximum penalty of one year imprisonment and \$2,000 fine.

The jury censured the use of threats and intimidation of WPA employees, enforced political contributions, discharge from work because of failure to contribute, enforced membership in political clubs "discussed" as social organizations, and diversion to personal uses of WPA funds, materials, and labor services.
