The Webfoots put themselves in that strategic position last night by toppling Oregon State, 48 to 37, to make up for O. S. C.'s upset win over Oregon last week.

Last night's game was exceptionally rough—14 personal fouls were called—and the crowd boomed both officials.

The Beavers, after a slow start, matched Oregon scoring for 12 minutes until the count was tied 9-9, but from then on the Webfoots stayed out in front.

While the victory may prove a life-saver for the Webfoots in their title bid, it wasn't much help to their star forward, Laddie Gale, in his effort to set a new division scoring mark.
