WASHINGTON, March 8.—(AP)—Secretary Ickes advised Senator Charles McNary yesterday he had approved a favorable report of the advisory board on historic sites to establish Champeog, Ore., as a shrine honoring the Oregon pioneers. The action included the Oregon project in lump sum appropriations. It was believed some financial co-operation might be requested from state and local organizations. Suggestions have been made for a museum-archives building, an auditorium and a memorial shaft of stone.
