## WOMAN BADLY HURT IN TRAFFIC CRASH

KLAMATH FALLS, April 19.—(AP)—Mrs. Edith Richards, about 60, of Portland was critically injured today when the car in which she was traveling alone went out of control and crashed into the concrete support of a railroad overpass on the Lakeview highway 12 miles east of here.

Mrs. Richards suffered a broken jaw, badly cut mouth, bruised right thigh and possible skull fracture. Her car was demolished.

The woman is the wife of Corry B. Richards, federal surplus commodities corporation employee at Portland, and a former Oregon City and Eugene resident. She was here to visit her son, Troy V. Wambaugh, a lumber worker.
