RECREATION NEWS

Douglas County Conditions Summarized in Forestry Service Bulletin.

All streams in the forest have fallen the past week. Waters are clear and fly fishing is improving in most districts. A moderate chinook run is reported from Winchester, where six of these fish were taken Wednesday of this week. The forest has dried out since the recent rains and recreationists are requested to use care with fire.

Diamond Lake District
Fishing: Fishing has been reported good at Diamond Lake, with 70 limit catches having been taken. Some of these catches were made with small hooks and single eggs. No reports have been received of stream fishing, but fishermen have gone down the North Umpqua river on the Thorne Prairie road as far as Pool creek. The road will be open as far as Lemolo falls, if not to the end of the road, by Saturday noon, June 3. Fishermen are reminded that Lake creek is closed to fishing from Diamond Lake to the North Umpqua road.

Roads: The Cascade Lakes road over Windigo pass is not yet open north of the Thorne Prairie road. Roads generally are in fine condition.

Accommodations: The Diamond Lake lodge offers cabins and dining room. Many well-kept camps are open to free public use. Recreationists seeking information at the Diamond Lake guard station should apply at the new forest service office east of the highway about half way around the lake. Outside of office hours the guard may be contacted at his residence located midway between the office and the lake.

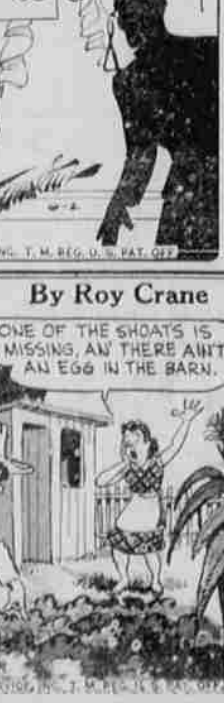
