BARNES APPOINTED ON CITY COUNCIL

SUTHERLIN, Aug. 12—Appointment of George A. Barnes as a member of the city council, succeeding D. E. Barnes, who has resigned, was announced by Mayor Martin Lloyd at the council's regular meeting held Monday.

City Treasurer W. J. Ladd submitted a report of the city's financial condition, showing \$2,000.00 on hand July 31, 1939. Other receipts were: liquor tax \$15.25, payment on land \$50, water collections \$123.05. Checks issued totaled \$948.40, leaving a balance on hand of \$7,300.78 on Aug. 1.

The usual monthly bills were ordered paid.

A restriction on use of water for irrigation purposes was ordered until further notice, water users being limited to the hours from 8 p. m. until 12 noon in using water for irrigation and sprinkling.

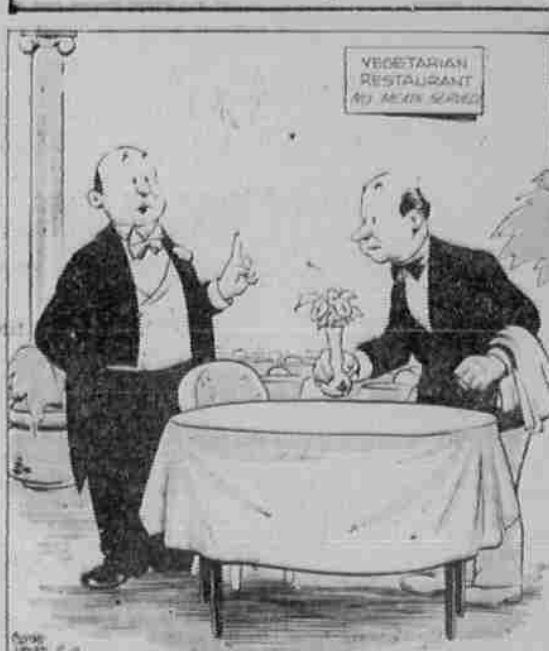
