

DIES GROUP ASKS ACTION ON GARDNER SHOULD HAVE WON RANSOM COIN BACK

WASHINGTON, Aug. 23.—(AP)—The Dies committee asked the United States attorney here today to take "appropriate prosecutive action under the perjury statute" or other affected laws against Frazer Gardner, who had been accused by Chairman Dies (D., Texas) of an effort to sabotage the house investigation of un-American activities.

A committee resolution covering that resolution was read into the record by Chairman Dies (D., Tex.) who earlier had said Gardner tried to get a job as a committee investigator while in the employment of an organization being investigated. The organization named was the Skyland Press, operated by William Dudley Pelley, leader of the Silver Shirts.

"The committee feels that the circumstances in the present case are of a specially grave nature," Dies said.

"It appears that the witness concealed and denied material facts for the purpose of securing employment with the committee as an investigator, in which position he would have been able to act as an undercover agent for an organization which is opposed to, and which is attempting to, sabotage this investigation."

Gardner is a resident of Washington. "This is a clear case," Dies said, "that Pelley and the Silver Shirts have undertaken by this method to secure information in advance and sabotage this investigation."

PUBLIC FUNDS TO PAY FOR OPERATION

GRANTS PASS, Aug. 23.—(AP)—Public subscriptions poured in today to help finance an operation for crippled "Jerky" Brubaker, 29-year-old Grants Pass insurance salesman who can walk only in a sitting position. A newspaper appeal brought over \$220 in 12 hours. Twenty years after Brubaker gave up hope that an affliction which struck him when he was two years old could be cured, he was told by Dr. Richard H. Dillemont, dean of the University of Oregon medical school, that tendons could be lengthened and that he could stand erect.

SHOULD HAVE WON RANSOM COIN BACK

NEW YORK, Aug. 23.—(AP)—Still weak from his ordeal as hostage of a band of Palestine Arab kidnapers, the Rev. Gerould H. Goldner, 29, of Mosadore, Ohio, told today how he taunted his 15 captors to play poker with deuces wild.

"It all started when one of my captors noticed that I looked pretty blue," the pastor explained. "He pulled out a deck of cards, and I thought him how to play with deuces wild and with seven cards. I won his shoes, hat, cloak, the rope around his head and all his cash."

The minister added that when his heavily-armed opponent pretended he wasn't looking he showed back the winnings to "save his face," an act which may have helped Mr. Goldner save his own neck.

The young clergyman and his father, the Rev. Jacob Goldner of Cleveland, were captured July 28 by the Arab band ten miles outside Jerusalem as they were returning from a visit to a Greek monastery. The father was released to arrange for the ransom, and his son was freed a week later on payment of "about half" the \$5,000 demanded.

RAW BEEF HELD TO CURE FOR "SHINER"

WASHINGTON, Aug. 23.—(AP)—Government scientists aimed a knockout punch today at the idea that a piece of raw beefsteak is a fine remedy for a shiner.

If you're unlucky enough to acquire a "shiner," and someone proffers beefsteak, the scientist said the thing to do is to eat the beefsteak—and apply a cold compress to your eye.

This advice was issued as part of a campaign by government experts at the agriculture department to educate the public regarding "shiners," the scientists termed "allergies."
