Bulletins in
ROSEBURG REVIEWBORDEAUX—That the allies
have been compelled to "give
ground in several places" in the
fighting north of the Rhine river,
was admitted by the war office this
afternoon. The development was
attributed to the heavy re-enforce-
ment of the German right.BERLIN—Portugal is believed to
be preparing to lend aid to the al-
lies. A number of British ships,
it was learned, have reached Lis-
bon. It is believed their business
is to transport the Portuguese
troops to the battle front in France.PARIS—Powerfully re-enforced
again, the allies are extending their
lines north of Arras, and a further
developing movement against the
German right wing has been under-
taken. Fighting desperately, the
Germans are retreating eastward an
inch at a time.LONDON—Having secured Rus-
sian positions in the Carpathian
mountain passes, the Cossacks are
now penetrating southward well in-
to Hungary, according to a Rome
