Roseburg high school's 10-year reign of supremacy over the elections of University high school of football came to an abrupt and tragic end last night at Finlay Gold, when the Golden Tides, playing heads-up and smart football, crushed the Indians, 26 to 7, in a free-scoring conference contest.

DeAutremont Sparks Victors

University scored its first touchdown over the Indians about midway through the first period with Chuck DeAutremont, Eugene's brilliant left half, hitting pay dirt from the 7-yard line on a wide end sweep after marching on its own 43-yard line in eight plays with DeAutremont, Gatlin and Plath alternating in packing the ball after a scoreless second quarter.

How Indians Scored

Roseburg scored its only touchdown of the game and the first of the season late in the last period while most of the reserves for both sides were doing duty.

Real Gridiron Battle

Despite the final score showing University out in front by 19 points, it was a real ball game the first half even though Roseburg, who barely eluded the outstretched fingers of a University secondary backfield, led 10-0 at the end of the first half.
