### Douglas County

Douglas county, Oregon, which extends from the summit of the Cascades to the Pacific ocean, has an area of approximately 4550 square miles. In other words the area of this one county in Oregon is equal to the area of the entire state of Connecticut.

The boundaries of Douglas county also mark the boundaries of the watershed of the world famous Umpqua river. This stream is a famous steelhead fishing stream. Trout abound in the small streams and tributaries of the main river as well as in the river itself. The entire eastern portion of the county is within the Umpqua National Forest and is a splendid recreational area.
