Probe Criticized****Federal Action Not Justified
Unless States Lag in Duty,
Governor Sprague Asserts.**

SALEM, Ore., Dec. 6.—(AP)—Governor Charles A. Sprague wrote the senate civil liberties subcommittee today that the federal government is not justified in taking steps to protect civil liberties unless the states fail to do so.

The governor, asserting he would be unable to attend the committee's hearings in San Francisco, wrote a statement to the committee.

"State governments ought to function adequately for the protection of all civil liberties," the governor wrote. "In case the state is flagrantly derelict in protecting the rights of its citizens, then the federal government is justified in taking steps to preserve such rights. But the federal government is justified in interfering under no other conditions. It is first the duty of the state, and the duty of the federal government when the state fails to act properly."

He said he knew of no "invasion of the civil liberties of agricultural or other labor in this state," but he pointed out that in 1937 and 1938 "there was a recurrent violence and invasion of civil rights inspired by a minority of union leaders in attempts at coercion of employers and workers."

It was terminated after public exposure and several convictions. "In answer to a question whether agricultural migratory workers have been deprived of their civil liberties, the governor replied in the negative, asserting 'friction which comes from industrialization of agriculture' has been minimized by the fact that most farms in Oregon are small and are operated by their owners."

The governor recognized there is a federal side to the question of migratory workers, particularly in

California "which has attracted many thousands of people from other states. . . . It is hardly fair for California to become a dumping ground for the propertyless and jobless."

**Jews Plead Evasion of
Nazi Reservation Plan**

PRAGUE, Dec. 7.—(AP)—Jewish leaders hastened today to remove possibly to overseas havens all male Jews under 37 from the German protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia before the deadline Feb. 28.

Havens overseas were favored over the Jewish reservation in former Poland, to which thousands have been removed recently. There are about 70,000 Jews in Bohemia and Moravia. It was estimated a large percentage of the men would be affected by the removal order.

All Jewish wealth is to be pooled to finance removal of the destitute. Others will be permitted to take with them 100 crowns (about \$2.45). Wives left behind may operate the businesses of their husbands, but it was understood women and children must leave later.

**Nazis' Overseas Trade
Ruined, Economist Admits**

BERLIN, Dec. 7.—(AP)—Emil Helfferich, one of Germany's outstanding economists, writing in Field Marshal Goering's periodical "The Four-Year Plan," declares the British blockade has virtually destroyed Germany's overseas trade.

"England's power has brought German overseas trade to a complete standstill," Helfferich says. He points out enormous quantities of goods for export are "piled up in all the larger German ports."

Importers and exporters are faced with serious problems because of "heavy taxation" and large overheads and must be given some kind of relief, he asserts.
