Once Noted Film Comedienne Dies
HOLLYWOOD, Jan. 5.—(AP)—Flora Finch, a famous film comedienne of the Nickelodeon days, is dead after years of obscurity.

An accidental arm-scratch led to a streptococcus infection which sent her last Saturday to a hospital. She died there late yesterday of blood poisoning and bronchial pneumonia.

Death claimed her a full quarter century after taking the round John Bunny, her starring partner in many an uproarious comedy in the magic-lantern period of motion pictures.

With the Finch and Bunny comedy team disrupted by his death in 1915, Miss Finch's popularity declined and there were years of slim earnings.

But for the past decade or more she was back on a regular salary, playing bit and extra roles. Never married, she kept near

Merger of Telegraph Concerns Recommended

WASHINGTON, Jan. 3.—(AP)—The federal communications commission recommended today consolidation of telegraph companies as "an obvious remedy for many of the existing ills" of the industry.

The firms affected are the Western Union Telegraph company and the Postal Telegraph and Cable corporation. Reports of proposals for merging the two companies have been heard for several years, and the senate last night directed the FCC to survey the situation.

Western Union has nearly 20,000 offices and Postal nearly 4,000. On last June 30, Western Union had 43,490 employees and Postal (and lines) 11,560.

The commission suggested congress remove the present prohibition against consolidation.

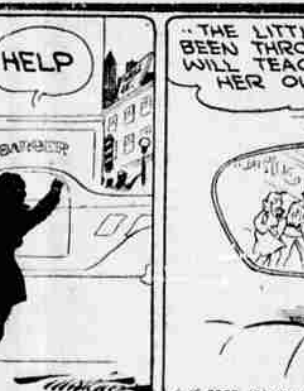

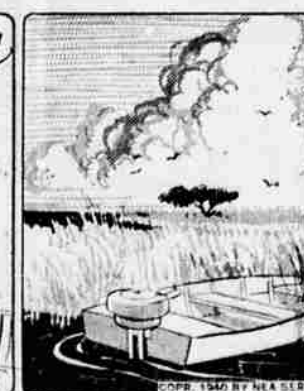
