Jobless Payment Law Goes to Court

With the arrest of William Herron, Portland oil distributor, the state unemployment compensation commission has opened a campaign to compel compliance with the act which became law more than four years ago.

Herron, who is charged with refusing access to payroll records by authorized auditors, is out on bail pending trial in circuit court later this month. On the outcome of this case depends the filling of other charges against recalcitrant employers, officials declare.

A fine up to \$500 or jail term up to 90 days is provided by section 26, which also covers failure to pay contributions, misrepresentation in obtaining benefits or wrongful deduction of payments from employee's wages.

Delays in benefit payments are due mainly to failure of employers to make wage reports promptly according to officials, who point out that ten field men are devoting their whole time to securing delinquent reports.

Rental Court Planned By C. J. Grimm and Son

Ground was broken this morning at North Jackson street and East First Avenue, North, for a rental court being constructed by C. J. (Curly) Grimm, owner of Grimm's grocery, and his son, George Grimm, manager of the store. The court, designed by William Bailey of Denn-Derretsen company, provides for five four-room houses of modern design.

The arrangement provides that each of the thoroughly modern cottages shall be independent of the other buildings on the property, except that two pairs will have common driveways leading to separate combination garages and fuel sheds.

Each house will have a large living room, with fireplace, kitchen, two bedrooms, bath and utility porch.

The buildings are to be erected by A. L. Andrus and John Atterbury.

SALEM, Jan. 11.—(AP)—Population of the Oregon state hospital reached an all-time high mark of 2,705 today, the hospital's capacity being about 2,300, Superintendent J. C. Evans said. Six hundred more patients are out on parole.

"The overcrowding makes it impossible for our staff physicians to properly segregate the cases," Dr. Evans said. "It forces us to mix the curables with the incurables, and compels us to use too much mechanical restraint on some of our patients."

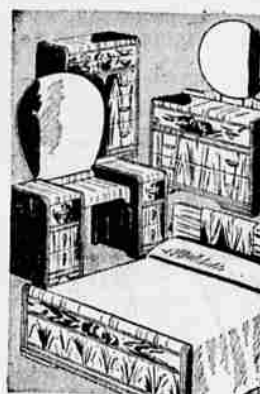

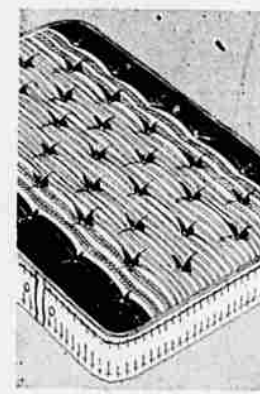
