SACRAMENTO, Jan. 19.—(AP)—Frank C. Jordan, 79, secretary of state for 49 years, a veteran of eight major political campaigns and the nation's secretaries of state, succumbed to uremic poisoning yesterday.

Funeral services will be held in the assembly chamber in the capitol Saturday, a state holiday by proclamation of Gov. Culbert Olson.
