

Roseburg Nurse Goes to Meet Kin

Mrs. Frank Middleburg Will Attend Ailing Grandchild Coming From Hongkong.

A cablegram received unexpectedly from a friend of her childhood days in Holland caused Mrs. Frank Middleburg, local nurse, to leave today for San Francisco, where she will meet a daughter-in-law and granddaughter of her long-time friend and will act as the child's nurse.

Her patient will be the four-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. E. Van Walree, who, accompanied by Mrs. Van Walree, will arrive early this week aboard the President Coolidge from Hongkong. The child is reported to be suffering from a serious eye disease. She was treated by specialists in China, Japan and Philippine Islands, and is now on the way to the Mayo clinic at Rochester, Minn.

Mrs. Middleburg was greatly surprised when she received a cablegram from Mrs. E. Van Walree, who was a very close friend during the childhood days they spent together in Utrecht, Holland. Mrs. Van Walree informed Mrs. Middleburg that she had planned to come to the United States to meet her daughter-in-law, but that she had been prevented by the dangers of travel in war-stricken Europe.

She requested Mrs. Middleburg to meet her daughter-in-law and grandchild at San Francisco and serve as companion and nurse during their stay in this country. Mrs. E. Van Walree, mother of the ailing child, is an Englishwoman. Her husband is engaged in the bookbinding business in Hongkong, while his father, the husband of Mrs. Middleburg's friend, is an outstanding banker in Holland.

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tion unanimously after giving Lewis a tremendous ovation. He concluded with the assertion that "I'm not going to take these things lying down as long as you're with me."

Lewis asked why the politicians had not answered his demands for a conference.

"Some gentlemen may tell you that his favorite politician is a great friend of labor and is lying awake nights worrying about the problems of Europe and Asia."

"But," he shouted, "that doesn't put my men to work in the coal mines."

Federal Laxity Chained

Murray told the convention: "The federal administration in Washington has evidenced no desire to cure unemployment. In Pennsylvania, which has 10 million citizens, one million are idle, and they represent three million people."

"Of this one million, only 225,000 are receiving relief. There are 665,000 left to shift for themselves—starving to death."

"If present conditions continue, an epidemic might develop from people seeking a right to live." Murray said he had appealed twice to President Roosevelt for a conference on unemployment, but Mr. Roosevelt "is fearful of disagreement, fearful that business leaders might not be willing to cooperate."

Johnson Sees "Strategy"
Gen. Hugh S. Johnson, here to address the convention, described Lewis' break with the new deal as clever political strategy. "Lewis is out to lead both parties," the former NRA administrator said. "He put them on the anxious seat. Labor should never let its support be taken for granted."

The CIO leader, in criticizing the Roosevelt administration last week, said the democratic party should not take for granted that it always would have labor's support.

Johnson said that in contrast to other "CIO" leaders were "people around talking and letting the democrats be sure of themselves." Johnson said Lewis had another good reason for splitting with the Roosevelt administration.

"Lewis has been getting a run around at the white house," he added.

The former NRA boss, whose speech was expected to keep national politics in a lively tone in the convention, predicted Roosevelt would be re-nominated and said Sen. Burton K. Wheeler (D., Mont.), who received a warm reception from the United Mine Workers, did "not have a chance" to get the nomination.
