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Insurance Angle in 2 Tragedies Bared

NEW YORK, Feb. 22.—(AP)—Assistant District Attorney Robert Thayer said today that John T. Geery, the suicide former official of the American Art Association, Anderson Galleries, Inc., had taken out \$150,000 in insurance on the life of his colleague, Milton B. Logan, in June of 1939.

Logan was mysteriously bludgeoned last Monday night while on an automobile ride with Geery and another man. Geery subsequently shot himself to death in his suburban home.

Geery, Thayer declared, was the beneficiary of both policies. He added that Geery's attorney, Herbert Plaut, had brought the policies to the district attorney's office.

Logan, who was president of the art concern before its bankruptcy last year, and Geery, who was secretary-treasurer, both were under indictment accusing them of having withheld some \$65,000 from clients in the sale of art objects.

Thayer, before putting the "insurance angle" into the case, had

declared that "bad blood" had existed between the two men, Geery having been the largest single loser in the bankruptcy.

Thayer said he was informed by Plaut that Geery had arranged for the policies at about the time he had negotiated with a soldier of fortune named Eckelmann for an extraordinary commission for the galleries to sell at auction some \$50,000,000 worth of art objects to be provided by Chiang Kai-Shek, the Chinese nationalist leader.

The prosecutor said he had been informed that Geery, in taking out the insurance, had explained it seemed justified in view of the vast nature of the Chinese project.
