Secret Explosive Will Be Tested

WASHINGTON, March 19.—(AP)—Chairman Sheppard (D., Tex.) of the senate military committee said yesterday the war and navy departments had agreed to give Lester P. Barlow, Baltimore inventor, an opportunity to demonstrate the power of a secret explosive which he and a collaborator have invented.

Sheppard made the announcement following a closed session of the senate and house military and naval committees at which Secretary of War Woodring, Secretary of Navy Edison and Barlow testified.

Each of the four committees, Sheppard said, would designate two members to witness tests on

land and sea as soon as arrangements could be made. Although details of today's meeting were kept secret, members said there was an "acrimonious" exchange between Barlow and the department officials.

They said there had been friction between Barlow and the departments because of his claims against the government on war patents.

Today's session was called to consider a resolution asking a congressional investigation of the possibilities of the explosive, which is made from liquid oxygen, carbon and other materials.

The committee heard conflicting claims as to this type of explosive.
