

Tex Carlton Hurls O-Hit, O-Run Game

Triumph Over Cincinnati Ninth in Row for Dodgers; Yanks Beaten in Rookie's Debut.

Nine straight victories, climaxed by a no-hit pitching performance from a 33-year-old Texas cowhand who almost decided to quit baseball last winter and stay at home on the range, show that Brooklyn is taking baseball seriously and will have to be taken seriously.

Tex Carlton's no-hit, 3-9 masterpiece against Cincinnati yesterday pitched up the fact that Brooklyn pitchers have allowed only 63 hits and 14 runs in nine games.

The homer that Oscarar hit with two on in the fifth to score all the runs of yesterday's game kept intact the Dodgers' average of a home run for every game since the start of the season.

The St. Louis Cardinals were rained out against the Giants yesterday, but the Pittsburgh Pirates were beaten for the fourth straight time, 6-2, by the Phillies, and the Chicago Cubs had an 8-7 squeeze to win in ten innings from the Reds.

With the returns from Cincinnati were posted yesterday, the plaudits of the baseball world were all going to a 25-year-old southpaw of the St. Louis Browns, Emil Bidilli, who stopped the world champion New York Yankees 2-1 on two hits in his first start in the majors.

The Cleveland Indians climbed back into exclusive possession of the lead in the American league with a 1-0 victory over the Philadelphia Athletics on Huddell's 12-11 hit pitching and two homers each by Tronzo and Keltner.

The Boston Red Sox, who had shared the top spot for a day, were 9-4 victims of the Chicago White Sox.

The Washington Senators bagged the Detroit Tigers 2-1.

Tragedies Hit Kin Of Local Resident

Mrs. Louis Fullerton of Roseburg is in Colfax, Wash., this week at the home of her brother-in-law and sister, Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Richardson, after tragedy struck twice into the family within a period of 48 hours, causing three deaths and one severe injury.

Mrs. Fullerton was called to Portland Sunday by the sudden death from heart failure of her brother, Roy Lyle, member of the Portland police department. Also attending the funeral services Monday were Mr. and Mrs. Richardson of Colfax, who received word that their home had been destroyed by explosion of a gas generating plant, causing the death of their son, Jack Richardson, and his wife, and severe injury to another son, Marion Richardson, who, however, is reported to be recovering.

Mr. Fullerton and small daughter, Mollie, who accompanied Mrs. Fullerton to Portland Sunday, returned to their home in Roseburg last night. They were accompanied home by Mrs. Fullerton's sister, Mrs. Elsie Erwin, of Cashman, Ore., who will remain here until Mrs. Fullerton returns from Colfax.

Accused Savant Defends Sex Views

LOS ANGELES, May 1.—(AP)—Dr. Bertrand Russell, the British savant, today defended his widely discussed views on sex with a declaration that "all my proposals in regard to the relationship between men and women were intended to bolster up the institution of marriage—not to abolish it."

Dr. Russell, whose expressions on sex and government recently resulted in the voiding of a teaching contract with City College of New York, has been named in new litigation to have him ousted as a faculty member at the University of California at Los Angeles.

Dr. Ira Wall, who described himself as a Baptist minister formerly of Fresno and the father of two children, instituted the proceedings which seek to restrain the university board of regents from continuing the philosopher's contract.

"Freedom is essential to physical well-being, mental advancement and spiritual progress," Dr. Russell said. "Victorian virtue was not the apotheosis of goodness."

Wealth Found on Man Who Dies of Malnutrition

SAN FRANCISCO, May 1.—(AP)—A pauper, elderly man—weighing but 74 pounds—collapsed on a park bench in Union Square yesterday and died later. Hospital attendants said death was due to heart disease and malnutrition.

Deputy Coroner Ray Brooks said he was Frank Schlott, 63, a retired shop worker of Richmond, Calif., and that in his pockets was \$2952 in cash and currency. Bank books showed deposits exceeding \$2900. One had a withdrawal entry of \$1860, dated last week.

The man had no known relatives here. He was a native of Germany.
