

Allies Undefeated, Briton Declares

LONDON, May 21.—(AP)—Alfred Duff Cooper, the British minister of information, acknowledged tonight the "grave" news of German successes, but told the people:

"The army of Great Britain and the far greater army of France are still there."

He added that the allies "are undefeated."

"Three facts alone can be definitely stated," he said in a broadcast to the country.

"First, that the present objective of the enemy is the channel ports from which they hope to launch war upon this island.

"Second, that small parts of the (German) mechanized troops have succeeded in eluding their opponents, in advancing great distances, and coming near to their objective."

"Third, that the armies of France and Great Britain are undefeated."

"In enormously superior number they (allies) occupy the battlefield and the counter-attack, when it comes, should prove formidable. The swaying fortunes of the fight matter little. It is the end of the battle that counts and... the end of this battle, whatever it may be, cannot entail the defeat of Great Britain or France in the war."

"The voice low and weary, at this dark hour for the allies, he insisted there was 'no cause for serious alarm, still less for panic,' despite the fact that it was 'no good pretending' that the news was not bad."

"In employment of a new technique," he went on, "small bodies of the German army have succeeded in penetrating to great distances, but they are small bodies only and the successes that they have achieved involve them in fearful danger."

Oregon Data Eyed In Skeleton Find

GRANTS PASS, May 21.—(AP)—Data from an age-old volcanic tomb were studied by University of Oregon scientists today as they checked over notes on a field trip to the Crater lake highway right-of-way where a second skeleton in 16 years was uncovered earlier this month.

Dr. L. S. Cressman, professor of anthropology, declined any statement here Saturday after his return from the expedition near Prospect where a skeleton was found sitting in a hole in pumice, deep under the surface.

"If it should be finally established," he wrote in notes received today, however, "that these Indians were killed by the hot pumice ejected by the eruption of Mount Mazama, then we will have more evidence to support that from eastern Oregon showing that human beings were witnesses of the formation of Crater lake."

Dr. Cressman said he believes a wealth of material for anthropological and paleontological study is located in this district and may be uncovered by hydraulic placer operations. He asked that he be notified and that finds be left untouched by the large gold-recovery operations barebones or artifacts. He said disposition of bones and their location in strata often means more than the bones themselves.

Simultaneously, the Red Cross announced its \$10,000,000 drive for war-relief funds had passed the \$1,000,000 mark.



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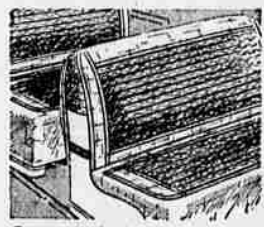
